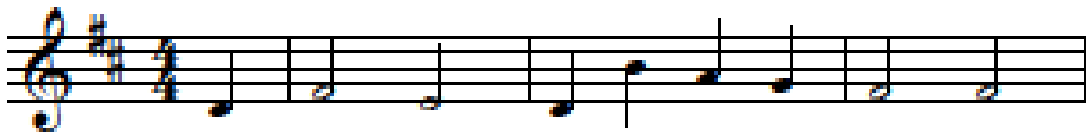

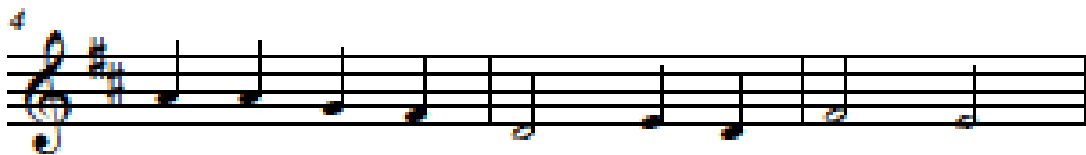
Congregational Hymn

After the choral introduction, the congregation is invited to join in singing the hymn. The hymn is printed on the next page.

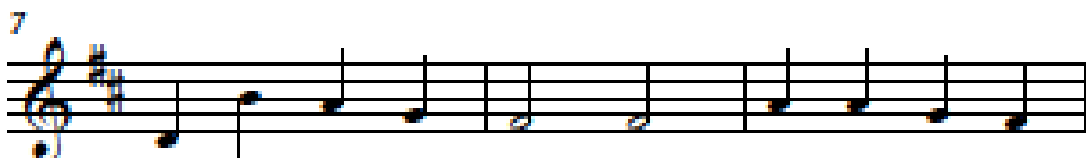

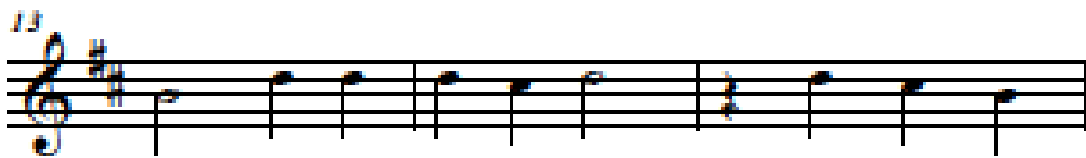

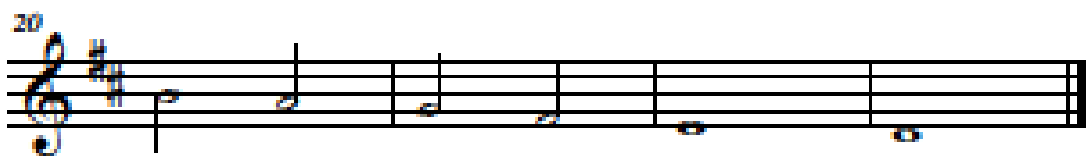
