### **BLC CLUB FUNDRAISER FOR CHURCH IN LEBANON**

Over the past three years Lebanon has faced a severe economic crisis, one of the worst since the 19th century. This has led to a near-worthless national currency and exorbitant cost of living increases. While this crisis has affected the entire country, its impact has been particularly devastating for smaller towns and villages like Barsa in the Koura district of Lebanon. Barsa is home to an aging yet vibrant community that is extremely devoted to its Christian faith. The local church holds a central role in the community where everyone attends Sunday service, weddings, town meetings, and much more. However, due to the economic turmoil, the local church has been struggling to maintain its services, with most of its resources being diverted to cover the exorbitant electricity bills. That's where our club, Bethany Lutheran College Enactus/DECA, comes in. We have a plan to install solar panels for the church, making it entirely reliant on solar energy. This will ensure a steady supply of electricity for the church to continue its vital faith services and community events. Our club's goal is to raise \$18,000 for the installation of these solar panels which also includes replacing the outdated air conditioning system with energy-efficient units which not only helps the residents, but the local environment as well.
