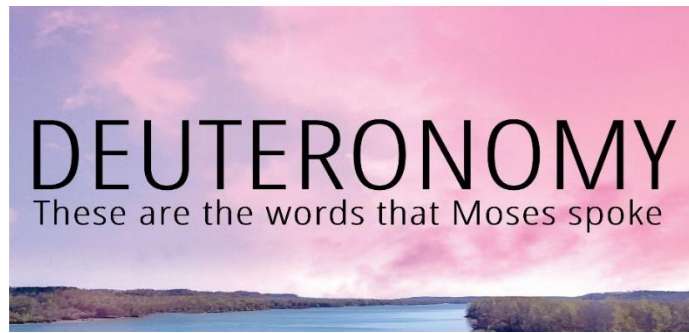

Sundays at 9:30a.m. Sept. 10th to Oct. 1st, led by Prof. Adie Harstad


