KINGSFOLD TO ACCOMPANY OUR SERVICES THIS WEEKEND

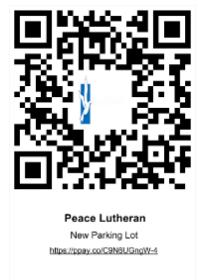
