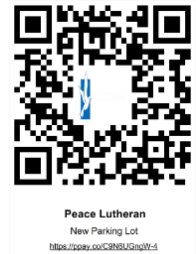

## \$50K FOR 50 PARKING LOT CAMPAIGN

At the annual meeting in June, the voters approved a **Parking Lot expansion of 50 stalls**. The Total estimated cost is \$143,000. We have funding through other gifts of \$93,000. The project will be approved if we can raise the balance of **\$50,000 by August 11th**. If we do then groundbreaking can proceed with an estimated start Date of August 14th. A special New Parking Lot Fund has been established for this purpose. Over the next 6 weeks our goal is to have 200 donations averaging \$250 per gift. 
