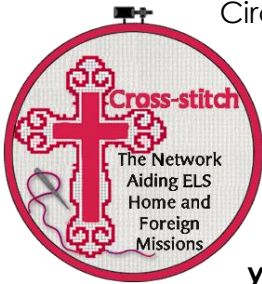
HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH EVENT
